Disease: Skabies



Group
Mites



Transmission
Direct body contact,
laundry



Saisonnality
Winter



Syptoms
Itching, burning of the
skin, skin changes
(redness, blisters,
nodules, pustules)



Further information
The mites live in ducts in
the top layer of the skin and
lay eggs there. After about
3 days, the larvae hatch and
grow into adult mites on the
skin surface.



**Spectrum of
activity**
At 50°C (e.g. in washing
machine, dryer) survivable for
no longer than 10 minutes.
