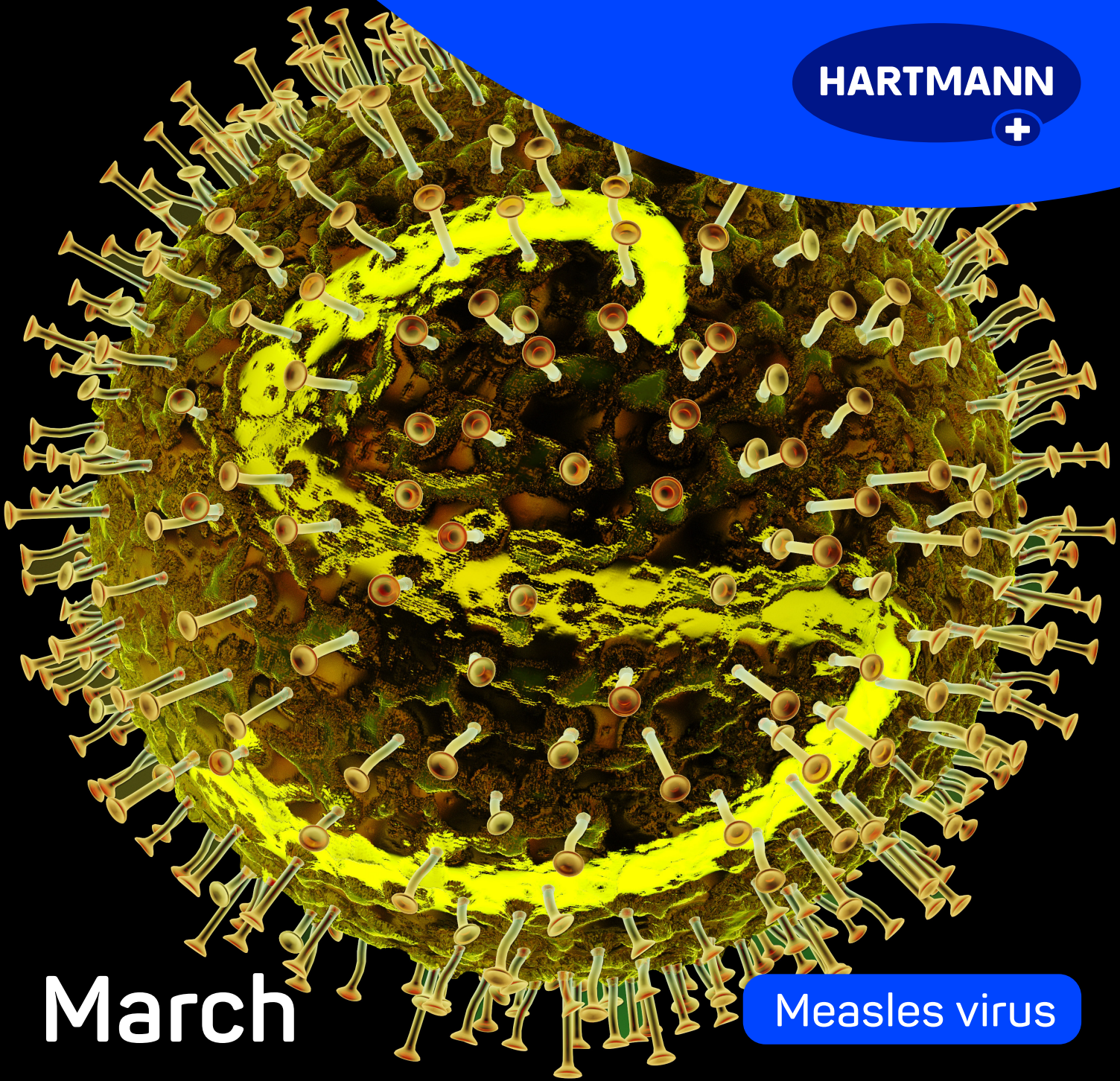

Spectrum of activity

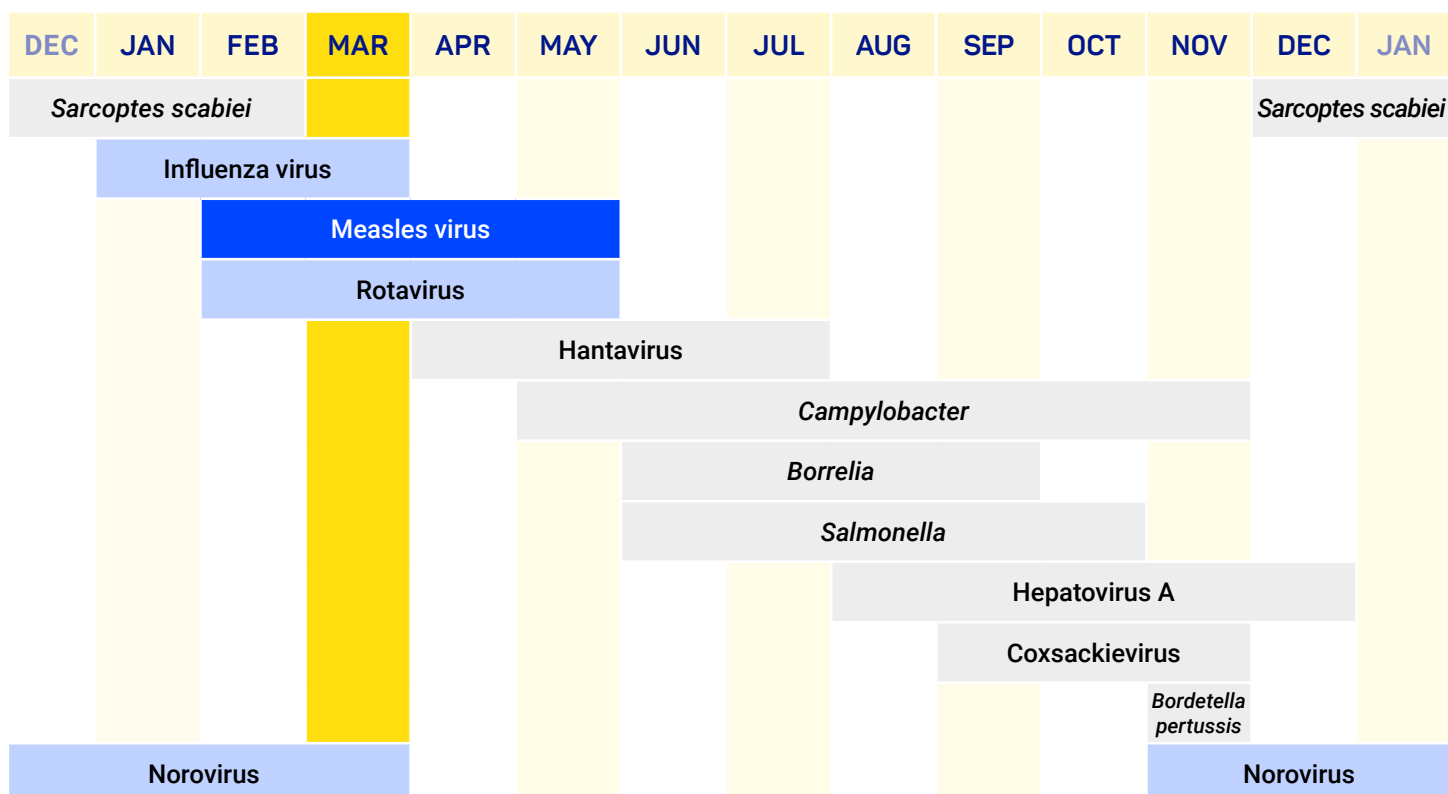
Virucidal activity
