


Dear staff and colleagues, you too can help to prevent the spread of pathogens. 5.5. is World Hand Hygiene Day. Join in!







BEFORE patient contact

Different nursing activities require several hand disinfections.

BEFORE an aseptic task

Disinfecting the hands prior to aseptic tasks is particularly important to prevent healthcare associated infections.



AFTER body fluid exposure risk

Gloves are a must when handling potentially infectious material, but are not a full protection against infection: Always disinfect your hands after glove removal!



AFTER patient contact

Hands need to be disinfected after touching a patient and before touching objects that are not in the patient's surroundings, e.g. ward trolleys!
