5 moments for patients & visitors

explain when hand disinfection is also necessary for you





AFTER contact with frequently touched surfaces in the hospital (e.g. doorknobs, handrails)



BEFORE and AFTER contact with own wounds, mucous membranes or venous access

or bedpan

Dear healthcare workers,

your patients and their visitors should also help themselves generously: When disinfecting hands, disinfectants should not be used sparingly.



Hygienic hand disinfection – this is how to do it:



Apply sufficient amount of hand disinfectant to the cupped hand so that all areas of the hands can be wetted thoroughly and completely.



Carefully rub in hand disinfectant **for 30 seconds** – cover all areas of skin.

Particular attention has to be paid to fingertips and thumbs.
